<b>Main Ideas</b>	<b>Questions/Activities</b>
<p>Students need to explore the meaning of the ritual action of Renewal of Baptismal Promises.</p> <p>Students need to explain the meanings of covenant and grace.</p> <p>Students need to explain the Church’s role in initiation.</p>	<p>Have the students reflect on what did they get out of the homily today? Students share responses to the whole group.</p> <p>Now want to ask students what comes to mind when they hear the word Baptismal Promises. May want to back track and ask the students what a promise is.</p> <p>Think about a promise. Want students to do the think about it.</p> <p>Want the students to break into small groups, they need to meet with students that they do not know. Have them discuss how they have grace in their lives. Have the students name some of the Graces in their lives.</p> <p>Come back as a group and do pages 6 and 7 as a group.</p> <p>Then, have students break up into small groups and do the share on page 7.</p>
<b>Critical Thinking Opportunities -Homework</b>
