Letter of what?

Like any Sacrament, Confirmation is freely given and freely received. This letter, written by each candidate and addressed to Father Kramer, is the candidate's opportunity to declare that they intend to be and desire to be confirmed.

What to write

- Explain the reasons you want to be confirmed.
- Why do you think you are ready to receive this Sacrament?
- Explain one aspect of the Catholic faith that became clearer to you through this process and tell why you believe it is an important aspect of your faith.
- Explain how you plan to continue being an active member of the Catholic Church after Confirmation.
- Explain why you chose the person for your Confirmation Sponsor.
- Explain why you chose your Confirmation name.
