As the sun sets on Thursday of Holy Week, Lent quietly draws to a close and the Church enters the most sacred and solemn time of the entire year, the Sacred Paschal Triduum. This is essentially one event that begins with the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, has its center in the celebration of the Resurrection at the Easter Vigil in the Holy Night and concludes with Vespers (Evening Prayer II) at sundown on Sunday evening. It is therefore most helpful to experience the Easter Triduum as a whole and not focus exclusively on Easter Sunday. The experience of the Triduum is greatly enriched by consciously participating in as much of the worship and quiet that characterizes this most sacred time starting Thursday evening. The Sacred Paschal Triduum is also enriched greatly by refraining from all unnecessary work as well as limiting daily routines, since this holy time is apart from and beyond the ordinary and commonplace. The more that we can experience this time as unique, the more the Holy Spirit is able to draw us more deeply into the celebration of life-giving love offered to us in the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus.
